School Uniform

May I remind you that Trinity School uniform must be worn at all times, boots and trainers are not appropriate to be worn in school, for clarification please find below the information regarding footwear as it appears in the school brochure:

Children must of necessity go out of doors on many occasions during the school day. Please ensure that they have well fitting, waterproof shoes. Shoes with high heels of any kind, or sling backs, are uncomfortable for a long school day, and potentially dangerous. Trainers are not part of the school uniform. In the summer months children must continue to wear socks, in the interest of hygiene and comfort.

Coming in to School

Please ensure your child does not come into the school using the main entrance in the mornings, they should use the outside doors

to their classrooms which are unlocked at approximately 8.45. Also, it is not necessary for children to deliver reply slips or trip payments to the office before school starts as they are all collected in class and taken to the office each morning. Thank you.
