School Entrances

As you will see the new gates have been installed. As noted in the last newsletter the pedestrian gate will be open at the beginning and end of the day during the busy times. During the rest of the day this will be closed and can be opened by contacting the office via the intercom system by the gate. To get

out through this gate there is a button just set back that is pushed to release the lock.

The front entrance also has a controlled access on it. This too can be opened through the intercom system at the side of the door.

The vehicle gates are automated. They are closed during the school day and will be opened by the office by using the intercom by the gate. As we have mentioned in previous newsletters vehicle access to the site has to be restricted to staff and some visitors due to health and safety plus security needs.
