This is just a short newsletter to keep you updated with the latest news and information from Trinity School.

School Uniform - Boots

It has been brought to my attention that some of the girls are wearing boots throughout the day, while I understand that during the colder weather the children might like to wear boots on the journey to and from school, it is not necessary for them to be worn all day in a centrally heated building. I would like to take this opportunity to remind you that Trinity School uniform must be worn at all times, boots and trainers are not appropriate to be worn in school, for clarification please find below the information regarding footwear as it appears in the school brochure:

Children must of necessity go out of doors on many occasions during the school day. Please ensure that they have well fitting, waterproof shoes. Shoes with high heels of any kind, or sling backs, are uncomfortable for a long school day, and potentially dangerous. Trainers are not part of the school uniform.
